
Employment Project



With your group members, produce a 10-minute presentation on employment in Japan in your chosen sector. Your presentation should include a summary of:

- 1. how recruiting works for this particular sector
- differences between this sector or work environment in Japan and the US
- 3. what kinds of positions are available
- 4. what companies or institutions in this area are looking for in candidates
- 5. what current students can and should do to pursue this field

Each group will also interview a professional with experience in their sector who has generously offered to volunteer their time. You will receive contact information later <u>and are responsible for scheduling a Zoom meeting.</u> Interviewees are volunteering their time and you will need to work around their availability. CC your instructor on communiqué and use <u>proper business email etiquette</u> (https://www.indeed.com/career-advice/career-development/how-to-write-a-professional-email). Use the experience and knowledge you receive from your interviewee as you put together your presentation.

Creation of a list of resources (links to useful information like recruiters, job fairs, company websites, blogs, etc) is also required. This should be included at the end of the presentation; presentations will be uploaded to Canvas for your classmates to use.
